Please give at least four weeks' notice and include information about the event, expectations of the library staff and any other requests. School event attendance and library tours are subject to staff availability.

Library Tours

Bring your class to the library for a tour. Tours are scheduled at least two weeks in advance. Visits are based upon staff availability for a given day, so alternative dates are always helpful.

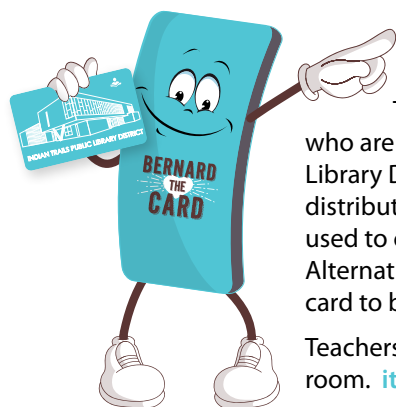
