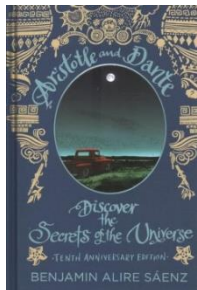

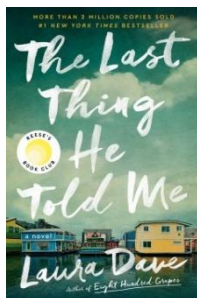


[Aristotle and Dante discover the secrets of the universe](#)

Descriptors: Coming of age, character-driven, well-crafted dialogue, thought-provoking

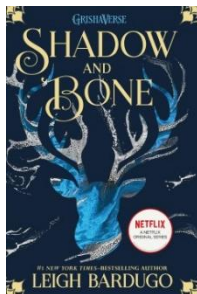

Descriptors: Authentic, intricately plotted, fast-paced, moving, compelling, book club

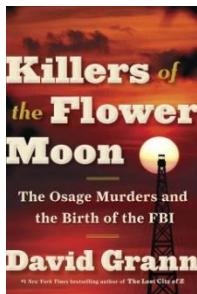


[Shadow and bone](#)

[Killers of the flower moon](#)

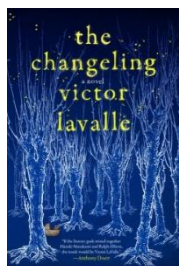

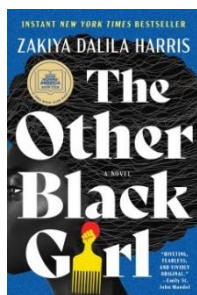


[The changeling](#)

Descriptors: Introspective, own voices, fast-paced, dark, humorous, thought-provoking

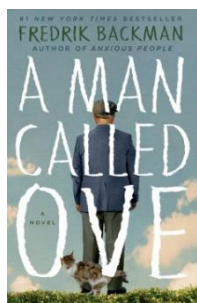

Descriptors: Moving, engaging, candid, book club

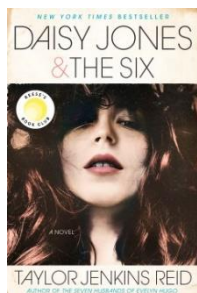
